Air Force school win Delhi leg of Arsenal tourney

YET ANOTHER Football camp conducted by an English club concluded here as Air Force School, Subroto Park won the Delhi leg of the Tata Tea Arsenal soccer stars tournament by defeating Shri Ram School on penalties at the Ambedkar stadium on Sunday.

The two-day inter-school event featured 57 schools from Delhi and NCR region.

The winners and runners-up of each centre will play in Kolkata for the National Championships on May 17.

But many foreign clubs have also conducted such scouting camps for children, but after the camp is concluded, the talents of those children are lost.

"The children who are selected for the Arsenal camp will be offered to play for different clubs and the club itself will be overseeing

their academic progress as well," said Jamshed Nasiri, former Iranian international and a selector in this tournament.

Three students were also short-listed to be part of the 30 students who will camp in Kolkata and out of these, 15 will be selected to participate in the Arsenal International soccer festival.

The students are namely- Avyay Gujral from Shri Ram School, Gurgaon, Daniel Lal from Air Force School, Subroto Park and Munmun Timothy Lugun from CRPF School.

"I am really very excited on being selected, though a bit disappointed on losing the final," said Avyay Gujral, one of the scouts selected for the Kolkata camp.

"I have already attended a coaching camp by Chelsea Football club in England and I would work very hard to go to Arsenal as well," he added.
