### **St Britto's emerge winners**

St Britto's High School of Goa emerged the winners of the national finals of the Tata Tea Arsenal Soccer Stars, held at the Howrah Municipal Stadium on Saturday. They defeated Angel's High School of Bangalore after a tie-breaker. Sixteen school teams from seven cities made it to the final round in an initiative, taken by Tata Tea in association with Arsenal FC to identify and nurture grassroots talent in the country. The event is supported by The Times of India. Football legend Chuni Goswami handed over the top scorer's award to Myron Fernandes of St. Britto's High School. City boy Karim Mistry of St Lawrence won the most valuable player award, Bengal pacer Ranadeb Bose giving the award to him. Jamshid Nassiri gave away the best goalkeeper's prize to Avijeet Dey of ASC School, Bangalore. Nassiri picked thirty players for a two-week long training here and in Shillong under the Arsenal coaching staff next month. Fifteen out of this group will then be selected for further training and an opportunity to attend the Arsenal training camp during the English club's International Soccer Festival in London in July.
